He had a guest starring role on “Ugly Betty” and Bravo’s “Make Me A Supermodel,” has appeared on daytime and late-night talk shows, and was a red carpet fashion correspondent for the 2008 Emmy Awards, 2008 MTV Movie Awards, a guest judge for the 2008 Miss USA Pageant and recipient of a Bravo A-List Award.
